Flex Alert Issued Calling for Power Conservation

Beverly Hills, Calif. – As high temperatures blanket Southern California for the next several days, Beverly Hills Cooling Centers will be open through Labor Day, Monday, September 5, to provide relief from the extreme heat. The following locations will provide a cool, air-conditioned environment:

In addition, the California Independent System Operator has issued a statewide Flex Alert for today from 4 - 9 pm. A Flex Alert is a call for voluntary electricity conservation due to increased demand on the state's electricity grid. With rising temperatures expected for several days, the Alerts are expected through the weekend. Workers in office environments are also encouraged to shut off any unnecessary appliances, computers, equipment and lights before leaving for the day.
